

## Excursion at l'Alpe d'Huez - Friday 2 February

### Practical information

- Meeting point at **6:15 am, Rue de la Frise, Grenoble** (at the back of the SNCF train station)
- You can take Tram A or B to the 'Grenoble – Gares' stop and then cross all the railways by the tunnel inside the train station, or walk from the 'Palais de Justice – Gare' stop of Tram B.
- All attendants must be well equipped for cold temperatures as we will stay the whole day outside at elevations ranging from 1850 to 2720 m a.s.l
- Lunch bags are provided by the conference team in the bus. Note that we will have lunch outside.
- All attendants must be able to **walk** about **1h30** in snow (groomed track) and wear appropriate winter mountain shoes. The whole group will walk, please do not bring any skis.
- Note that the program might change in case of bad weather conditions, please be attentive to the last information provided on Thursday 1st February
